The Director of Agronomy (DOA) is responsible for consistently providing exceptional golfing conditions and the management of golf course maintenance and landscape operations. The DOA is expected to lead a talented, long tenured golf course maintenance team and to possess strong agronomic, business and communication skills.

The DOA must be an excellent, transparent communicator with a natural style of "sincere engagement" with both the Club's management team and members. He/she will have extensive agronomical knowledge and know-how. Embracing an immensely successful golf course maintenance program will be critical along with continuing education, professional development, strong peer group relations, and staying at the forefront of research and technology are necessary for success. The DOA reports to the Club's General Manager.
